NEW Business:

- **1.** Anthony Reed from United Way came to talk to us about funds to help our Sierra Vista friends with rent and utilities.
 - \$77,209 has been granted for Friends with addresses in Sierra Vista (85635 85650)
 - These funds must be used between 10/1/22 through 3/31/23 or the city takes it back.
 - \$5,000 for food in these areas: \$3,500 of that is to be used for Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets to be distributed through the Dream Center. \$500 to AZ Prep for

- kids. .\$1,000 to the SVdP Food Bank.
- \$35,000 for rent. The rule is a one-time, up to \$375/household. \$19,000 for Utilities a one-time, up to \$300/household.
- \$3,000 to GNA for hotel vouchers. Brad will be who to contact.
- \$7,500 to Arizona Housing Connection for Homeless Assistance.
- Any funds not used will roll back into rent and utilities.
- **2. M**inistry Fair had 4 possibly interested and donations.
- 3. Tuesday, Sept 13th is SVdP Corporal Mass @ 9:00 a.m.
- 4. October 1, WALK FOR THE POOR...more info to come. I will send the flier out to all in case you have a FB page to post it.
- 5. Food Bank:
 - When getting a food box to deliver, please turn the slip in just before needing it filled.
 - Filling the fridge with water bottles will be the Vincentians responsibility.
 - Bread shortages may cause the Food Bank to have to purchase bread.
 - Milk and frozen meats are carefully checked. Meat is good 10 days past the shelf date (and is frozen immediately upon pick up) Unopened milk is 5-7 days beyond the date.
 - Ask our Friends their situation for food. Car? Bicycle? Walking? Refrigeration available? Are they able to cook? It helps to know how to pack their food box.
 - If homeless, please don't automatically check the Transient Food Box. A Transient box is for the Friends that have neither of those and need shelf stable foods.
 EXAMPLE: If the Friend has a hotel room with a microwave/refrigerator or a camp stove, they can get a food box.
 - October 3rd begins the sign-ups for the Thanksgiving Turkey Boxes. At our next meeting, we will review the sign-up sheets and discuss the process and particulars.

- Mary Ellen shared that the ceiling has been taped, textured, painted and the floor is next.
- Dennis shared that the furnace/bathroom drywall is wet and they are locating the leak.
- We are taking donations M-W-F 9:00-12:00

- 8. FREE PHONES: Stand Up Wireless ACPO lifeline program has a tent and table set up on Bartow near 7th Street. Monica Armenta (520-987-1131) indicated that she will be there for at least another week. Sun -Mon 8:00-5:30. Our Friends need an unexpired ID and be on some form of government assistance program Food Stamps, ACCHS, SSI, or have a low income. Tablets are also available for \$10.
