1. 2<sup>nd</sup> Job Announcement for the store for an Assistant Manager will be posted with AZ @ Work by 3

February and will run through the end of the month.

- 2. Leah came to the meeting and told of some changes. Leah has implemented the "Square" for credit card purchases, eliminating the need for a separate machine, and the fees, of up to \$1,100/month. The Square charges a flat 2.95%. The Thrift Store staff is adapting quickly.
- 3. SVPD's Cpl Borgstadt will come on Friday @9:00 to speak with the staff regarding how to handle a robbery at the Thrift Store. Nothing is worth their safety.
- 4. Temporary committee regarding the AZ @ Work will meet with Jerry to see how to best proceed to help our Friends toward a positive employment outcome. They will be coming as Guest Speaker 2/6/23
- 5. Code Red: How can we help a fellow Vincentian when a Friend's visit comes to an end and the lobby has more Friends in need of help? Maybe a code/password between Vincentians?

- 7. The Better Bucks Workforce program for homeless and city has begun.
  - The homeless, and others, can register to work for the program, paid daily. More information to come.

- 8. Our Guest Speaker, Robert Oates, explained how ViCap (Volunteer Interfaith Caregiver Program) drives people 60 and older and disabled of any age in, Cochise Cty. There is no charge for local, and request a donation for Tucson. They are available for medical appointments and grocery shopping in person/or for a grocery pick-up and delivery.
