- 1. Pauline has the Ozanam Certificates for the Vincentians that attended. Those Vincentians were not able to be at the meeting tonight.
- 2. Pauline sent flowers were sent from SVdP for the Memorial of Rev. Virginia Studer to be held at the Presbyterian Church on 22 July @ 10 AM. Virginia supported our Backpack Program.
- 3. Our funds that we used to help Friends are going fast. If the file for that fund says \$0, do NOT deduct any more funds. This is causing dipping into future funds. The Friend needs to help. Ask questions, why are they in this situation? Do they truly have a need, or is it a want.

- 4. Pauline is checking into why we are on the window at SSVEC as an emergency funder.
- 5. Ask and make more detailed notes in the Friend's file. READ the previous input. Some of the details don't match up to their reasons for not working, or why they are needing our help.
- 6. Maury told of the SVdP Food Bank, a man came in and used the cardboard box to swat the store manager, and she picked it up and swatted him back. Be aware of your surroundings and moods of our Friends. NOTHING is worth your life. Suggestion of having SVPD come and talk about de-escalation in a situation.
- 7. FELLOWSHIP in August on the 14th. Tonianne, Ms. Grimsley, Barbara Sisneros. We will check with them. There will also be 5 and 10 year pins awarded.
- 8. In spite of receiving COVID PPP monies, Pauline learned there is a chance we may be eligible for the ERC/Employer Retention Credit for previous Covid 19 and will pursue looking into

this.

- 9. Pauline did a little demo showing a rinse-free body washcloth, just needs water added for the soap, and cloth for wiping dry. We will place them in the backpacks for the homeless.
- 10. Nicole Velasquez a Case Manager from Telecare. Nikki shared what they do to help our community. She shared their curriculum book, and gave pamphlets for information at the Conference. They are a tremendous support for our Friends for helping them with life skills; accompany our Friends for support, de-escalation, shopping, at doctor appointments, etc. They help by administering medication and more. A perfect example is our own Teresa Blye.
