1. Last week we had over 19 new people registered into the system.

2. Managing our funds. We read this together.

We walk with the poor and see them through emergency situations. We need to ask ourselves: Am I seeing them through the emergency or being arbitrarily over helpful?

- Our Guidelines need to be followed. Our guidelines are set in order to help as many Friends as possible.
- Suggested questions to consider when working with a friend for any help particularly rental/utility help.
- When we pay more than the emergency requires, we are cutting into funds for the next Friend in need.
- Ask a Friend has been on the SSVEC account long enough that they can fall back on their original deposit?
- SWG has a LIRA (Low Income Ratepayer Assistance) ask if they have applied.
- SWG grant is back. Have the Friend fill out an application.
- Free phones are available instead of paying a payment. Walmart has a place to turn in a phone for payment.
- When a Friend truly needs internet for work, etc. They can use their cell phones internet, and hot spot. If they are in a rural area, have them check into internet specifically for rural areas.
- Sewer and water may not be an emergency as a payment plan can be set up.
- Mortgage payments are not usually an emergency. It takes months before any action will be taken
- 3. To Discern means: to recognize.
- 4. Community Partners amount has been capped at \$6000/month.
 - This is a Cochise county wide program however our conference will work in the confines of 85635: 85650: and Huachuca City as we always do.
 - Discern over the funds
 - Write up the Diversion funds request, please elaborate and print legibly.
 - Put Friend's name on backside
 - Annotate in the Community Partners folder for the request
 - Give the request to Blanca for emailing
 - Update the Friend's file that CP is pending.
 - Much discussion whether we should use our Conference's guidelines.
- 5. If you make coffee at the end of the day please check that grounds are dumped, coffee pot is cleaned and unplugged.
- 6. Our Friend's bathroom needs to be checked, frequently throughout the day, for toilet paper and cleanliness.
