#### Old Business:

1. Community Partners has been responding quickly for fund requests. The amount remaining today is \$1,515.72. A Vincentian can approve \$300; up to \$425 can be approved if the Vincentian consults with the other Vincentians who are working; anything over \$425 requires approval by the Special Case committee. Community Partners money is for use in the Sierra Vista/Huachuca City area only. Please log your cases in the Community Partners Log once approved. If requests come in for other parts of the county, call the respective SVDP Conference. Stephen asked can we use Community Partners funds if a friend has already had

- \$1,000 in assistance. The answer was no since we are to follow our guidelines.

  family".

- 3. When you get help from St. Andrew's, please put it in the St. Andrew's log and be sure to include the name of the person you talked with at the church; i.e., Gloria, Rosie, Lupita or Kate.
- 4. New Budget: the finance committee met on Friday. We were blessed to have lots of funds the last few years. We approached the budget assuming that we would not be receiving any grants or large donations; we have to rely on sales from the store and donations. Therefore, the amount of funds available to help our friends will be limited. The board will meet on 26 September 2023 to finalize the budget and set guidelines on how much assistance we can give our friends. Gini said that on Monday, there will be new folders with new guidelines in the back office; please familiarize yourself with these guidelines.
- 5. We are looking for a new Treasurer. Gini has done an excellent job as our treasurer for the last five years. Please prayerfully consider being our new Treasurer. Gini will happy to mentor you.
- 6. With the possible federal government shutdown, we may see some government folks coming in for help.
- 7. Father Greg received an email from Mayor McCaa asking for help with the migrants. Donations of food, clothes, paper supplies, diapers can be dropped off at the Salvation Army, which is the collection point.
