- 27 May 2024: The Conference and the Thrift Store will be closed on Memorial Day, 27 May 2024. Please remember those who died for this great country.

Old Business:

- 1. The USPS Food Drive: Approximately 21,000 pounds of food was collected. We had many volunteers from the food bank and their family members, Life teen teens, LDS members plus members of Hoops House.
- 2. The pot luck last week was good.

NEW Business:

- 1. WANTED: District President. Ann Lee is stepping down in September. Pauline has a list of responsibilities if anyone is interested.
- 2. The Ozanam training was outstanding. We had 20 participants. What stuck out from the training? Spirituality increases within the conference, with our friends as well as implementing more home visits. Modeling St. Vincent De Paul, Fredric Ozanam, and Rosalie Rendu has proven to be essential when doing home visits. Quality not quantity was also talked about. Maury also stated that if a family refuses a home visit, they should not receive any further help from SVDP. Both Mechelle and Tom attended the training and soon will be inducted as Vincentians.
- 3. When making a payment for a friend using one of SVDP's charge cards, never make the payment in the friend's presence and never use the friend's phone.
- 4. A friend who has a handicapped child with autism needs a live-in person. If you know someone or a friend comes in that might fit the bill, please contact Michelle Davis, 414-938-9880 with the name and phone number of that person.
- 5. The Thrift Store has 2 positions available a part-time driver and a full-time cashier. The Thrift Store is also looking for Vincentian volunteers. If you go in to volunteer, please use the front door and let them know when you leave.
- 6. There is a room for rent in a family house for \$500 a month plus some utilities. The room has its own bathroom, new painting, new carpet and new ceiling fan fixture. A person with a monthly income is preferred; no smoking inside house or bedroom. Room will be available in July. The contact number is 424-240-2269. We should vet any friend for good character before informing them about the room. The homeowner will make the final decision.
- 7. The Silver Rose prayer service will be held at St. Andrew's on 28 May at 6:00 PM. This is a National pilgrimage stop on the way from Canada to Mexico to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe.
- 8. The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage has started from 4 different locations throughout the United States and all routes will lead to the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis on 16 July 2024.
- 9. Pauline got an estimate from Mountain View HVAC for 2 of the 4 coolers at the Thrift Store which will be paid from by our anonymous donor. Pauline asked if they would give us a discount and they lowered the price by \$500.
- 10. School will be out this week. If a family needs food more than once a month, please give it to them. Also, please make sure to put the ages of the children on the slip
- 11. Diane thanked the members of the Ad Hoc Committee for their work on updating the guidelines. She said the final guidelines should be out by mid-June and that information will be discussed 2 weeks prior to implementing. A summary of the guidelines follows:
- a. The purpose of the committee is to identify problems and try to fix them with standardized guidelines. The new guidelines will try to make rules more standardized based for 12 rolling months (i.e. Jan-Jan; May-May, etc.). The amount and funds used for payments should be highlighted in the friend's file.
 - b. How do we assist friends who have multiple visits and how often do we help them.
 - c. We need to ensure that case file notes clearly explain what was done for the friend.
- d. Currently, 80% of money is used for rent and utilities; 11% for the homeless; and 9% for everything else.
- e. There will be 7 files 4 major ones rent, utilities, homeless and other; 3 other files Fernandez, single moms and St. Andrews.
- f. The Vincentian will not have to decide what funding sources rent will come from if another funding source is used in addition with the rent funds. As an example, if we pay \$300 rent for a friend, we currently take \$200 from Good Shepherd fund and \$100 from SVDP fund and we mark both files. Under the new guidelines, we would annotate the rent file for \$300 and Blanca and Glen will work where the money came from.
- g. Special Cases will still be used; however, the funds for the special case will come from whatever funding source you need, i.e. money for rent from the rent fund. A special case form will be

required when requesting a special case.

- h. The "Other" fund will be used for items other than rent and utilities. It is a stand-alone fund and not an add-on fund.
 - i. Only one additional fund will be used to supplement rent/utilities.
- j. We shouldn't help with taxes, mortgages, sewer and trash (unless it is part of the water bill), deposits of any kind, automobile loans and automobile insurance.
 - k. The rules are meant to keep it simple and make it easy.
 - I. If a homeless friend has a DNR at the first place that's called, no other calls should be made.
